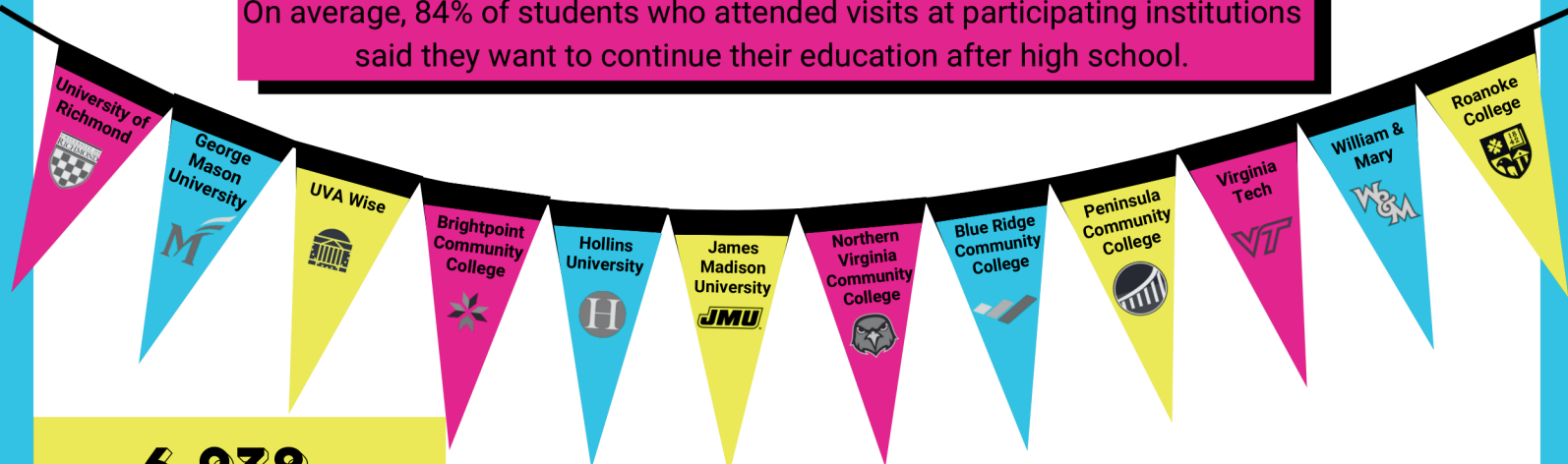


# MIDDLE SCHOOL CAMPUS VISIT PROJECT

The Middle School Campus Visit Project aims to promote high school graduation, college enrollment and degree attainment among underrepresented and underserved youth while fostering a sense of college readiness among middle school students (grades 6-8) from low-income communities.

## 84%

On average, 84% of students who attended visits at participating institutions said they want to continue their education after high school.



### 6,938

students participated in campus visits

### 46

college campuses were visited by students

### 261

family members participated in the campus visits



72% of students described their tour as very informative

72%

81% said the campus provided a welcoming environment.

81%

54% believed that the college has degree choices that match their interests.

54%

Comparing pre-visit to post-visit views, students also appeared to have more knowledge of some key higher education topics. For example:

## 15%

increase in the number of students who said they know "a lot" about college entrance requirements after the visit.

## 22%

increase in the number of students who said they know "a little" or "a lot" about federal grants for college after the visit.

## 11%

increase in the number of students who said they knew "a lot" about college majors after the visit.
