



INFORMATION NEEDED TO COMPLETE THE 2025-2026 FAFSA

Students and their contributors (parents or spouses) might need the following information to successfully file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA):

- StudentAid.gov account (aka FSA ID) - Students and their contributors must create separate accounts to access and complete the form.
 - Don't have a StudentAid.gov account yet? Create one now at StudentAid.gov/fsa-id.
- Tax returns for 2023
- Records of child support received
- Current balances of cash, savings, and checking accounts
- Net worth of investments, businesses, and farms
- List of schools the student is interested in attending
